**OPEN HOUSE on Thursday evening, May 13.** In preparation for this, **each child is assigned and will be submitting an “INVENTION” or “PROJECT”**

made from ordinary household items: boxes (oatmeal, egg cartons, etc.), cans, paper towel/T.P. rolls, Popsicle sticks—whatever. This may include any number of simple scientific experiments they can share with the class and show at Open House. **If you need suggestions, see me**, however I know the children are quite creative and probably will not lack for some idea. The project may be something requiring assistance to complete but should **primarily be the work of the child**. This would include painting and assurance that it works if it “does something”. This project will be on display for Open House and **should be at school by Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>**. We will be using this project as a learning tool and introduction for putting together a successful project in future school years. **(Please see attached sheet)**
