Spelling: List 1 Test Friday

Math: Begin unit 1. We will cover pages 32-39.

Language: Unit 1 “Verbs” pgs. 2-8 (This is in-class work. Any homework will be written in their assignment notebooks.)

Reading: Windows to the World. This is a new reader for fifth grade. We will be working with its stories for the first quarter. The first two stories will be covered this week.

History: Chapter 1 – 2 Introduction to the eastern hemisphere and to the “Fertile Crescent” pgs 1-8
